SEESAW SET UP

1. Download Seesaw for Students onto an iPad, Laptop or PC.

How to use Seesaw on your devices

Seesaw works great on any computer or device

1. For the best experience, bookmark and use app.seesaw.me on your desktop or laptop computer (including Chromebooks).
2. Then, if you or your student(s) use mobile devices, download the correct app based on your role and device type, so you can access Seesaw anywhere!



2. After payment has been made for State of the Heart's program, you will receive your child/ren's learning code.



Tapine's Home Learning Code

1. Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS or Android device.



2. Choose 'I'm a Student'.



3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account:

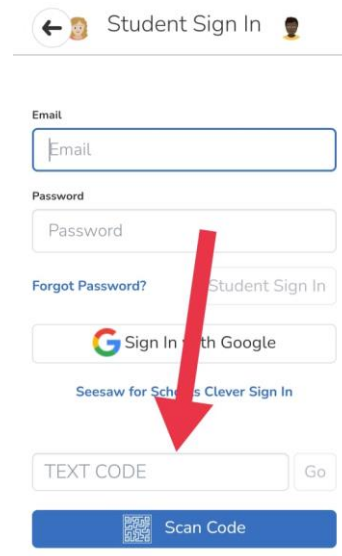
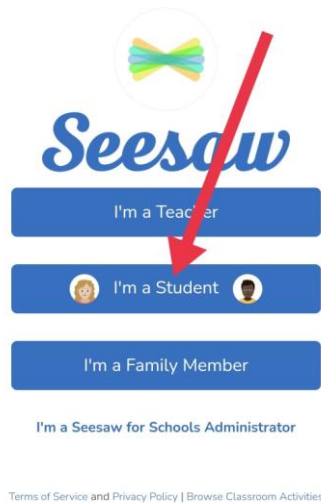


Ask your teacher for a new code after December 3, 2022.

4. You will then see your child/ren's classes and assigned activities. HAVE FUN 😊

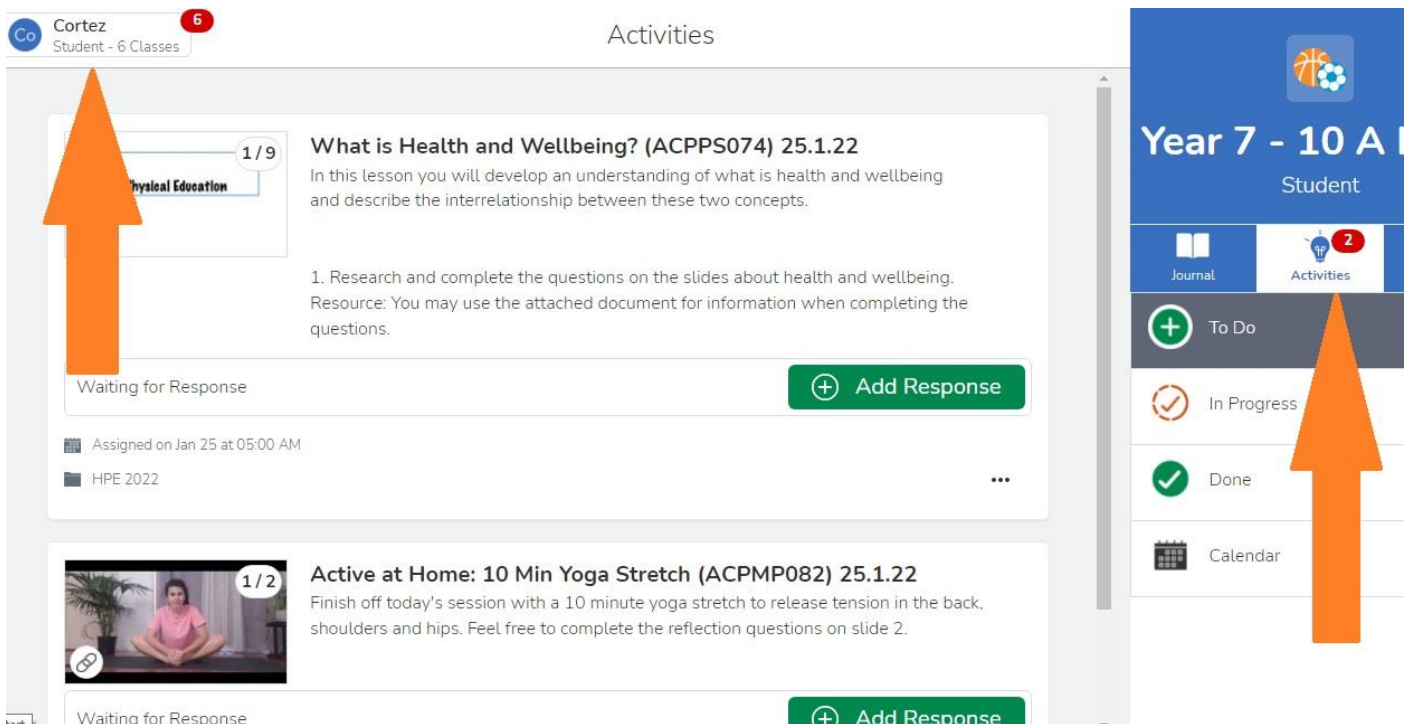
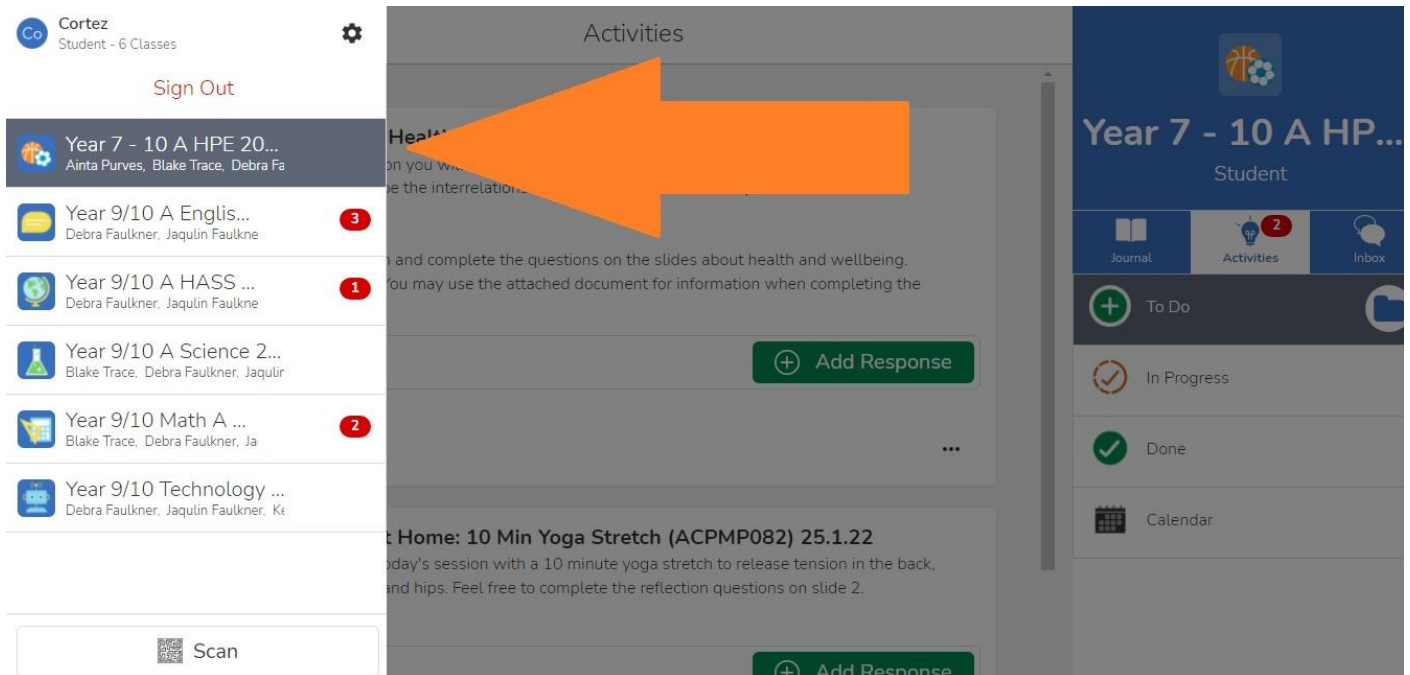

1. When you log in, your classes will be displayed by clicking the box at the top left-hand corner. Select the class you are wanting to go to, then on the right-hand side of the screen, click 'ACTIVITIES'. Your scheduled activities will then appear.

At the bottom left-hand corner of the activity you will then see the COMMENT option. If you want to continue working on your activity, click the three dots in the right-hand bottom corner and select, 'EDIT POST'.

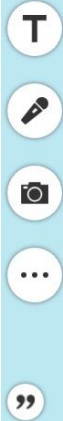
